The children worked very hard to achieve these results and we are so proud, not just of the children's attainments but also their attitude to learning, the

way in which they have developed a growth mindset and their great sense of enthusiasm. I am equally proud of our very strong, talented and supportive team of staff, who inspire and support the children throughout their primary years enabling them to really flourish at Ide Hill.

Pupil progress is measured between the end of Key Stage 1 (year 2) and in year 6. This year, our pupil progress data is as follows:

We are exceptionally proud of this progress data, which puts Ide Hill School in the top 10% of schools in the country for reading and maths and in the top 5% of schools for writing - a fantastic achievement!
