
Parking

In May, we celebrated Rogation Sunday. Traditionally the priest and members of the parish would walk around the parish boundaries so everyone knew what land belonged to each parish. Young boys would have their heads knocked onto landmarks marking the limits of the parish as a memory prompt! Nowadays as we have maps, they are saved from this!

We also planted radishes and asked for God's blessings on crops planted for this year here and around the world.
