fantastic. Thank you – Sharon (PTA Chair)









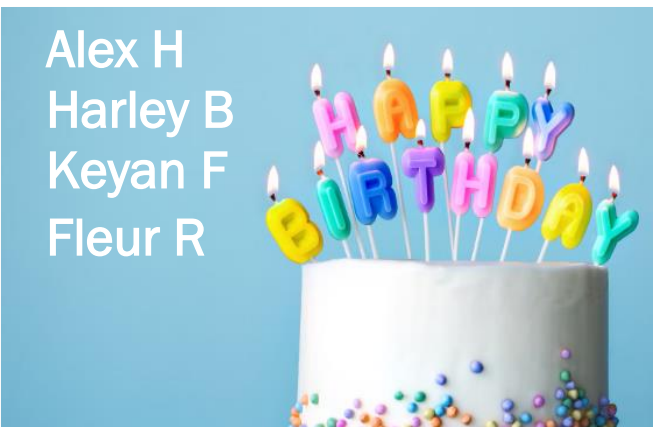


Christmas Fair
