

Kent Test – 9th September

Next Thursday, some of our year 6 children will be taking the Kent Test. The children will be completing their tests in Oaks classroom with school staff and a visiting invigilator whilst the remainder of the class learn in the library. On the day, the children are required to bring a bottle of water and may bring a fruit snack and a small mascot if they wish.

We will guide the children through the tests, making clear the amount of time that they have to complete each section, when to move on and when to stop.
