A quick update - as we come to the end of another school year the children have been focusing on the last two principles of Nurture:

1. Language is a vital means of communication
2. The importance of transition in children's lives

These are particularly important for children at this time of year with Y6s moving on to secondary school and other classes moving up to a new class and teachers. We will also be welcoming our new Saplings in September which will be a significant transition for those children moving up from pre-school or nursery. We have been encouraging the children to communicate their feelings, whether negative or positive, through language and talking, so they feel comfortable to talk to someone about their emotions through our PSHE lessons, using Zones of Regulation, the Colour Monster, Nurture groups and using our Nurture Nooks. Staff have been planning transition events for the children in order to support them on their journey through the school and beyond.

The Nurture UK programme will continue to be developed, as a whole school approach, from September and we look forward to bringing you all along with us.
