Major Roadworks

Please be aware that significant road closures are planned that will impact Ide Hill for a long period.

Roadworks are due to start on **Monday the 8**th **January** along the A25 starting between New Road and The White Hart Pub due to gas network upgrades. The works are expected to last around 12 weeks and will inevitably cause some disruption. Although the school is aware that this may mean some children are late to school, we ask please that you plan your mornings and afternoons to allow for potential delays so that there is not a knock on effect at school.

KCC will be resurfacing Ide Hill Road in February. This means that the road will be closed between the Gracious Lane/Wheatsheaf Hill junction and the Bough Beech turning from 19th February to 2nd March 2024, which will make access to Ide Hill very difficult. It is assumed that the work will be done in sections, but at this stage no further information is available.
